

Thief Ant

Size: Workers are 1/16 long.
Queens are 1/4" long.



Description:

- Colour is Pale yellow to light brown.
- Antenna are 10 segmented with 2 segmented clubs on end.
- Thorax has no spines.
- Pedicel is 2 segmented.
- Very small stinger.

Habits & Signs of Infestation: Thief Ant colonies consist of thousands of workers and many multiple queens. They nest in crevices, wood and concrete joints and enter buildings normally in hot weather.

Inside they prefer meat and animal fats as their prime target foods, but will feed on any high protein such as nuts, fruit and dairy products.

Outdoor colonies will feed on almost anything from honeydew to dead animal carcasses. These ants forage in distinct trails from food sources back to nesting areas.

Control: Careful inspection and observing all ant food trails back to nesting locations is important. Dusting of all voids into colony nest sites, combined with residual liquid spraying along the outside perimeter ant trails, will eliminate the colonies.
